The following is just a suggested daily tour schedule. You will have complete control over your daily schedule and may change your plans at any time by simply telling your guide.

Day 1

Kotor

Today your guide will meet you upon your arrival in Kotor at **9AM** for a visit of this beautiful seaside town. Start your visit in Kotor with a visit to the Catholic Cathedral of St. Triphun from 12th century with reliquaries of St. Triphun from 9th century. Continue to the Orthodox Church of St Luca from 12th century, as well as the Franciscan Church of St. Clare from 16th century with baroque marble altar of Francesco Casabianca.

Continue towards Njégoci – a typical Montenegrin village. In Njégoci you will have the opportunity for a light snack. A special tasting of the local honey wine, accompanied by homemade cheese and prosciutto has been arranged for you.

Later you will drive to Cetinje, where a visit to the Monastery of St. Peter has been arranged. We have also arranged for a special visit to the Montenegrin Institute of Monument Protection. Here you may visit the restoration area of the institute and learn how Montenegro's deep artistic history is being preserved. You may also visit King Nicola's Museum- the only king of Montenegro.

Optional Active Excursion: Time and fitness permitting, you may consider climbing the 1,500 steps of Kotor's old fortress walls on the hills above the town. The fortifications were started in the early Middle Ages by the Byzantines after expelling the Goths and were later expanded by the Venetians. Throughout the centuries, the city survived many attacks and was successively controlled by Bulgarians, Serbians, Venetians, Ottomans, and Austro-Hungarians. Nowadays, the impressive city walls stretch some 3 miles from the waterfront to the steep cliffs above the town, range in thickness from 5 to 50 feet, and offer some of the best views over the Old Town and its surroundings. There are several access points to the fortress walls, so one does not necessarily have to walk their entire length. As this is completely independent, no extra guide services or costs are associated with this.

Note: Even though you have a vehicle today, please wear comfortable footwear. The terrain is uneven and requires a significant amount of walking.

SIGHTSEEING

Sightseeing arrangements have been made with your special interests in mind. Your drivers and guides are at your disposal for full or half-day sightseeing programs as indicated in the itinerary. Within those time and mileage guidelines, your driver and guide are at your disposal, so you are free to modify your program as you please. Should you require additional time or mileage, the costs will be quoted on request and may be paid for locally in the local currency or U.S. Dollars.

Every effort has been made to confirm that scheduled sightseeing venues will be open at the time you plan to visit them. However, individual estates, museums, gardens and other points of interest can change their hours of operation at short notice. In the event that a particular attraction is closed on the day or time of your visit, your guide will offer alternative arrangements or rearrange your sightseeing to accommodate these unexpected events.

OPTIONAL EXPENSES

Charges for extra meals, transport, sightseeing services or other optional additions to your established itinerary are your responsibility and must be paid locally in the local currency.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities are not included in your tour price. Your copy of "Travel Tips" contains suggested gratuity guidelines for your consideration. Gratuities may be extended in the local currency, U.S. Dollars or Euro.

DINING WITH YOUR GUIDE

On days when dinner and lunch costs have not been included in your itinerary (or in your tour cost), you may, at your discretion, choose to invite your guide to dine with your party. You are under no obligation to do so but, if you do extend such an invitation, the guide is your guest and you will be responsible for the cost of his/her meal.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

CANCELLATION

Written cancellations received less than 60 days prior to departure are subject to the following forfeit of tour cost

- 59-14 days prior to departure, 50% of total tour cost
- 14 or less days prior to departure, 100% of tour cost.

REFUNDS

We regret that refunds cannot be issued for arrangements confirmed on your itinerary but unused once your tour has begun.

INSURANCE

Exeter International strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance to protect your investment. You will find insurance costs noted on your invoice and insurance coverage information in your original booking packet.

PRICES AND ARRANGEMENTS
