Day 1



Stockholm

This morning your driver and guide will meet you on the pier.

Stockholm, Sweden's capital, was built on 14 islands connected through a network of waterways and more than 50 bridges. Known as "the Venice of the North", it is hardly surprising that Stockholm is a city best seen from the water. Recognized for their modern design and freshness, the Swedes also take great pride in their customs and traditions.


Begin with a tour of Gamla Stan (Old Town) to explore the narrow winding streets and historic buildings. Storkyrkan, the Great Church, is set in the heart of Old Town. Dating back to the early 1500s, the Lutheran church is Gothic design and has been the setting for numerous royal weddings.

Next your guide will take you to visit at the imposing City Hall, Stockholm's political center and site for the annual Nobel Prize festivities. The Golden Hall is covered in millions of mosaic tiles depicting Sweden's history and most famous sites. The Blue Hall holds a pipe organ which, with over 10,000 pipes, is the largest musical instrument in Scandinavia.

Continue onto Djurgården, a natural resort in the heart of Stockholm. Here you will visit the Vasa Museum. This is Scandinavia's most visited museum, for its maritime history and housing of the Vasa warship. The Vasa, perhaps the grandest and most ambitious ship ever to be built in Sweden, is the city's prized treasure. She capsized and sank straight to the bottom on her maiden voyage in the 17th century only to be salvaged nearly 333 years later in 1961.

Transportation

In general, drivers have limited English-speaking skills. Evening transportation is not included unless specifically noted in your itinerary. Timing for each day is noted in your program.

Tickets

All entrance tickets as described in the program.

Shore Tour Documents

Shore tour documents are electronic and are emailed approximately two weeks prior to travel. These include all the emergency contact details you will need. You have your choice of receiving these via PDF or via the AXUS app.

SIGHTSEEING

Sightseeing arrangements have been made with your special interests in mind. Your drivers and guides are at your disposal for full or half-day sightseeing programs as indicated in the itinerary. Within those time and mileage guidelines, your driver and guide are at your disposal, so you are free to modify your program as you please. Should you require additional time or mileage, the costs will be quoted on request and may be paid for locally in the local currency or U.S. Dollars.

Every effort has been made to confirm that scheduled sightseeing venues will be open at the time you plan to visit them. However, individual estates, museums, gardens and other points of interest can change their hours of operation at short notice. In the event that a particular attraction is closed on the day or time of your visit, your guide will offer alternative arrangements or rearrange your sightseeing to accommodate these unexpected events.

WHEELCHAIRS

Exeter wheelchair service can be arranged at most ports; however, the cost of the rental includes extra time for delivery and return. Often it's a better value to bring a wheelchair from the US with you on your cruise, or to arrange a cruise-long rental via a third party company like www.specialneedsatsea.com. Please do note that our guides cannot assist with mobility-challenged guests to be lifted or pushed in wheelchairs. If a member of your party cannot push the wheelchair, we will have to hire a wheelchair pusher, at additional expense. Drivers cannot be expected to help disabled guests in and out of vehicles. They can manage the wheelchair (collapsible) in and out of vehicles. They will be required to stay with the vehicle and will not be available to assist beyond the vehicle.

OPTIONAL EXPENSES

Charges for extra meals, transport, sightseeing services or other optional additions to your established itinerary are your responsibility and must be paid locally in the local currency.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities are not included in your tour price and are at your own discretion. Please see your final documents for tipping suggestions.

DINING WITH YOUR GUIDE

On days when dinner and lunch costs have not been included in your itinerary (or in your tour cost), you may, at your discretion, choose to invite your guide to dine with your party. You are under no obligation to do so but, if you do extend such an invitation, the guide is your guest and you will be responsible for the cost of his/her meal.

Booking Conditions

PAYMENTS

Exeter International must receive a deposit of 25% of the total program cost before reservations for your independent travel program can be initiated. The balance of payment is due 60 days prior to departure. *No reservations are made on your behalf until this deposit has been received.* Availability and pricing is subject to change until this deposit is received. **All deposits are nonrefundable.**

CANCELLATION

Written cancellations received 60 days or less prior to departure are subject to the following forfeit of tour cost

- 60 -14 days prior to departure, 50% of total tour cost
- 14 or fewer days prior to departure, 100% of tour cost

Once an itinerary is finalized and final payment has been made, a \$100 revision fee will be charged if the itinerary is changed.

REFUNDS

We regret that refunds cannot be issued for arrangements confirmed on your itinerary but unused once your tour has begun.

INSURANCE

Exeter International strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance to protect your investment. You will find insurance costs noted on your invoice and insurance coverage information in your original booking packet.

PRICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Once an itinerary is finalized and final payment has been made, a \$100 revision fee will be charged if the itinerary is changed.

The tour price includes planning, handling and operational charges. Rates are quoted in US Dollars on the current rate of exchange and tariff as of 2020. Exeter International reserves the right to increase tour prices to cover increased costs, tariffs and taxes, and to reflect fluctuations in foreign exchange markets.
