



Russia Visa Processing

Our goal is to make the issuance of your Russian visa as easy for you as possible. When planning an itinerary that includes Russia, you have a choice of hiring an outside visa service or asking Exeter to obtain your visa for you. We want you to choose the processing route that you prefer.

Option A: Hire an outside visa processing service (please note that the Russian Consulate will not accept an application directly from you by mail; some Russian Consulates accept applications presented in person). If you choose to hire an outside service for your visa processing, we will provide you with the Visa Support and Invitation, which you will need to obtain your visa. After we send this invitation to you, all visa application questions must be directed to your chosen visa service. Each consulate is slightly different in their needs and only your visa processor can answer your questions for you.

Option B: Purchase Exeter International Full Service Russian Visa Processing

Simply answer the questions below (in complete detail and accuracy) and return this form to Exeter International with your actual passport, one (1) color passport photo and visa processing fee (rates below). Please note that your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the END of your time in Russia and you also must have at least two blank visa pages in your passport.

Multiple Entry Visa (3-year validity)	\$600 per person**

**Multiple Entry Visas have to be processed a minimum of 20 days before departure.

Your passports will be sent back to you directly from our visa manager in Washington DC.

ALL PASSPORTS MUST BE SIGNED IN INK BEFORE SENDING FOR PROCESSING.

Expedited processing times may be available on a case-by-case basis.
